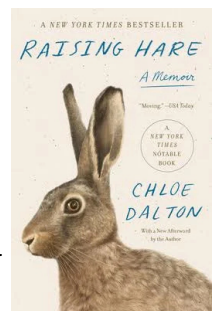

For no extra cost, you can donate to the Dexter Senior Center just by shopping at Busch's. All you need is an email address and a Busch's MyWay account. People who already have a MyWay account may not have an online version. Setting up a new online account involves a two-step process. 1) Clicking on the Create Account link takes you to a form to complete. Once this form is completed, you are then prompted to log into your email account to click on a verification link. Then do the following steps: 1) Log onto your MyWay account through Buschs.com. 2) Click on your name in the corner. 3) Go to MyWay in the middle and scroll to MyWay Account. 4) Click on "Cash for Education" 5) Scroll down and choose Dexter Senior Center and Click "add".
